Rules for Volunteers

This year we are opening up our camp to anyone wanting to attend with a parent working. Boys registered do not have to attend with parent unless they are a tiger (1 grader in Fall 2017). All pack must provide a 4 to 1 ratio of boys to adults. Talk to your Pack Coordinator for Camp for more details. Girls may attend if they have a parent working camp in any job. They can do the same program as the boys. The only parents that have to be with their children are Tiger cubs. A parent can work any job except Key Staff without being registered with the Boys Scouts of America. See Flyer for more details on registering and read job description about all the jobs we need filled.

If any of you want to invite your Church or Santiago members or any other group to join us please do. We have prepared a flyer you can hand out.

It is now even easier to become a volunteer. With the new rules we do not have to enroll in the BSA. This means that we can get parents, grandparents, friends, co-workers to volunteers.

Here is the steps for Volunteering:

1. Registration online (Adults must pay \$10 for water bottle, Shirt and backpack) Have adults that are not registered in the BSA put the number of the pack, troop, or crew they have friends in. If community volunteer register under pack 000.

2. All participants have to submit a Camp Compliance form for the Criminal background Check (CBC) when you register.

3. All adults must turn in a BSA medical form. Please fill out to the best of your ability. All adult must have taken a Tetanus Shot within 10 years of camp. If you do not believe in shots for personal or religious please fill out exempt No Shot form.

4. ALL STAFF & Volunteer Must be trained for all adults! All staff 18 and older must attend one of the following sessions!

Youth Protection Training will be offered: (Add Dates)

In classroom YPT 9:00 AM Saturday at (location). You will not be allowed to attend camp if your do not have this training. Training good for two years card must expire after June (last day of camp), 2017.

Regular Staff & Volunteer training follows YPT class on dates listed. Should last about 1 Hour (10:30 - 11:30 AM)

EXTRA Help Needed- Any adult with a American First Aid Training please submit a copy for camp! We need at least 1 adult trained for every 25 people at camp.
